**Come learn the basic techniques of making a rag rug. Robin Kearns and Gayla Macomber will teach you how to tear, roll and crochet fabric for an afternoon of fun. At the end of the workshop, you will have a finished trivet (hot pad) to begin your own chair pad or rug. Robin and Gayla will have several examples of items you can make using the same technique. If you joined in last year and would like to complete your project come refresh your memory with help from Robin and Gayla.**

**The workshop will begin at 1:00 pm and will wrap up around 3:30 pm. You will need a 15.75mm crochet hook and 1 ½ to 2 yards of cotton fabric, feel free to bring your own or we will supply them for you. Space is limited, so register early.**

**Your cost includes admission to the Interpretive Center, so plan to come early and enjoy the exhibits or plan to stay a few days for the Labor Day Wagon Encampment with live oxen and musical performances from Phil and Vivian Williams Sat, Sun and Mon August 30<sup>th</sup>-September 1<sup>st</sup>.
