1. The plan must comply with the Endangered Species Act, unlike WOPR.
2. It must get the approval of US Fish and Wildlife scientists, so we don't lose our clean drinking water and a significant source of tourism, jobs, and resources.
3. Although even more increased timber cuts are proposed to "bail out" counties in the wake of cuts in Federal payments that have existed since the early 1900s, those increased timber cuts will only decrease jobs and resources in the long run. There is not even much of a market for timber, since the extreme international decrease in demand for new housing and retail buildings. Hence, these increased cuts are wasteful giveaways. The resulting lack of forest canopy and shade will increase erosion, fires, global warming, poverty, and ugly landscapes.
