Comments:

1. There must be no more clearcutting and spraying with toxic chemicals. Thin and selectively log only. Narrow 'tier' strips are OK if there is no herbicide spray. 2. There needs to be restoration work where replanting was too thick and there is little or no biodiversity. 3. The reprod must be returned to native forest with a wide variety of native shrubs, trees and plants, especially berry plants for birds. 4. Sediment sources must be found, repaired and replanted with erosion preventive vegetation. 5. Stop poisoning and killing wildlife who were there first. If there is a problem, it's our own encroachment that caused it. 6. Bears need berry fields and roots. Give them back their food source instead of harming them further. Leave plenty of quality habitat for wildlife everywhere, including shelter, cover and food. 7. Leave threatened wildlife alone. 8. BLM must manage O&C forest, not theiving timber pirates of private industry. 9. Enforce the log export ban. 10. The reason there isn't enough tax revenue and jobs for counties is the plywood mills were mostly moved to China, and, 11. there is no Severance Tax for big timber companies any more. Oregon must fix it's tax code, not throw away all that's left of our public forests, watersheds and wildlife habitat. 12. BLM does a fine job almost always.
