

Dear Bureau of Land Management:

I am writing to express my concern about the Western Oregon Plan Revisions proposed by the BLM. I believe that all the three alternatives proposed are unacceptable because none of these provide sufficient protection for Oregon's forests or endangered species. Alternative 2, the "Preferred" alternative, is worst of all because it allows aggressive clearcutting.

Please return to the drawing board and propose a fourth alternative that puts species preservation, clean water, and saving of old growth forests as highest priority. In particular, please ensure that a particularly valued old growth area near Eugene is preserved as a Late Successional Reserve/Late Successional Management Area: T19S. R06W. Sec 17, the "Grandmothers" of Wolf Creek, which is valued by many Oregonians for environmental education and recreation.
