I am writing about the Western Oregon Plan Revisions, through the BLM, which would affect nearly 2.6 million acres of federal forests.

I strongly object to any plan that would not honor the Endangered Species & Clean Water Acts. I strongly oppose adding 1,000 miles of new logging roads & thousands of acres of clearcuts and significant increases in old-growth logging.

We can sustain the economic value of forests by redirecting plans toward thinning pre-existing plantations and cutting small diameter trees in areas where it would not damage water quality and habitat. We must not sacrifice these beautiful forests for very short-term financial advantages.

Please consider the wishes of the people of Oregon by sustaining our forests in a responsible manner and not put the timber industries first with lack of regard for these beautiful and life-sustaining forests.
