Cover Letter on Behalf of the Fourteen Enclosed Letters  
from Lane County Citizens  
in Regard to the WOPR Draft Environmental Impact Statement

To: BLM

In regard to the WOPR Draft Environmental Impact Statement, all fourteen of the enclosed letters prefer:

- 1) **NO INCREASE** in logging on BLM lands;
- 2) Of your various listed options, we prefer whichever one will result in the least increase, or, preferably, a **DECREASE** in the current level of logging on BLM lands, believing it to be detrimental to a healthy environment, especially in regard to the watersheds. **Currently, we believe that the listed option that comes closest to our desires, and thus the one that each of the enclosed letters prefers, is the 'TAKE NO ACTION' option.**

**ALSO:** We are fully aware that you no longer expect to get your 'preferred Option Two' through; however, we will NOT be satisfied with any option that increases logging on public lands and will not consider that you have somehow 'compromised' when you move off Option Two to another slightly better option, **as we have expected you to do that from the very beginning.** By asking for more than you expected to get, then settling on what you think you can really get, you are not practicing 'compromise'; rather, you are practicing 'manipulation', and we see right through it.

My own more detailed response to the Draft Environmental Impact Statement will be sent separately, as I am still composing it.
