In regard to the John's Peak Timber Mountain Off Road Vehicle Plan, I have gone to three meetings and written three letters to which no one would listen and no one would respond.

At one meeting, a representative from the motorcycle club said they would bring in hundreds of thousands of dollars from all over, like Florida, New York, and Canada. Nothing was said about how much it would cost to put out the wild fires they will start. And they will start fires. There is a lot of brush land and timber.

I saved your butt once when I found a tag line 300 feet into my land. I showed your BLM logger the corner, and he really thanked me. He said they would have logged my land.

I have lived here for 75 years. I know there are bear and cougar in the BLM lands around my property, and they will be down here if harassed by ORVs.
