

Dear Sirs:

As small woodland owners in Oregon, we support the BLM to develop a new "Modified Alternative 2 Plus" plan which would harvest 960 million bdft annually. The wise use of forest products is important for our society to decrease our environmental impact. Wood use in construction has a much smaller "environmental footprint" than alternatives such as concrete and steel. Wood is also an important source of renewable energy, and growing more trees as well as using more wood is an important carbon sink. Oregon mills need to be able to count on a sustainable supply of timber to continue to operate and grow. Greater management intensity of BLM timberland can contribute to our economy, as well as increase our environmental friendliness.
