

Dear Mr. Reuwsaat,

I am writing in reference to the proposed OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE PARK for the Worthington / Obenchain area in Jackson Country Oregon (Western Oregon Plan Revision)

This plan which encourages off highway vehicle use in this area would be disasterous for the following reasons:

1. soil erosion would destroy Little Butte Creek and the resulting salmon spawning.
2. just think of the added fire hazard from the large quantity of vehicles and smokers.
3. this is a protected area for the elk and deer. Vehicles would destroy their winter range and the noise and poachers would chase them out.
4. all other peaceful – quiet use of the area would be discouraged and impossible. Loud motorcycles can be heard for miles.
5. the added traffic on Worthington and Obenchain (currently gravel) would destroy the roads and require costly paving - \$5,000,000.00, Who will pay?

Again, this proposal is against everything the BLM stands for, please help to kill it.
