Dear BLM,

I am writing to express my sincere disagreement with the WOPR. This plan should be changed to not include old growth stands in the harvest. The recovery plan that is being proposed downplays the importance of the remaining stands of old growth. This is a mistake. Old growth habitat is needed for northern spotted owl and the marbled murrelet.

In addition the proposal to add 1000 miles of new roads will eliminate the necessary tree buffers along rivers and streams where salmon spawn. Watersheds, which many of us rely on for drinking water, will be damaged.

I strongly oppose this plan.
