
To the BLM:

As an Oregon voter and U.S. citizen, I strongly protest the disregard shown in the BLM's favored WOPR for the quality of our lives and our ecosystems.

Clear-cutting, widespread use of herbicides, low concern for the habitat of endangered and threatened species—not to mention low regard for human and planetary health, as the quality of our watershed degrades and carbon locked up in ancient trees is released—these should not be the goals or plans of an agency established to manage public land for the perpetual national welfare.

Thinning crowded stands of 2nd growth timber, though more difficult and less profitable, would get the job done in a sustainable way. This is still distasteful, given the need for increased oxygen, decreased carbon; but it is a compromise we can live with for a while. I hope it is given due consideration.
