Dear Bureau of Land Management Personnel:

This letter is in response to the BLM management 's long range plan for OHV's in the Quartz Creek area

It has been my privilege to live and own property at 3200 Quartz Creek Road since 1980. This location makes me aware of a possible accident prone situation you may be aware of also. Very near the entrance of Quartz Creek Road from Hugo Road is a bridge over Bummer Creek. This bridge allows for one way traffic. Unfortunately traffic coming down the hill on Quartz Creek Road is unable to see approaching traffic until close to the bridge.

Residents who know this situation are courteous and there have been few incidences at the bridge. However with increased use of this road by OHV's and those transporting them it is my opinion that this presents a real problem. Some official sign should be posted to indicate "Right of Way"

In the past building restrictions have been enforced that prohibited building permits to future families who desired to build up Quartz Creek because of this one way bridge. It seems strange that former restrictions about increased traffic on the bridge have been overlooked under the present plan as Quartz Creek Road has become a very busy road for those riding or hauling all-terrain vehicles.

Quite naturally local residents are dissappointed that BLM has chosen Quartz Creek Rd to accomidate those who seek recreation through all-terrain vehicles but for safety sake some official sign should be posted to indicate "Right of Way".
