



Susan Creek



Located in a beautiful setting of mature trees along the North Umpqua Wild and Scenic River, Susan Creek is our most popular campground. Enjoy a ranger-led campfire chat Friday evenings in July and August, hike the North Umpqua Trail, or visit the new Tioga Bridge-located within walking distance of the campground. The Susan Creek Day Use Area is just a half mile stroll away, from there it's just .75 more miles to the Susan Creek Falls. Fishing is restricted by ODFW to fly-fishing only, so get a copy of the Oregon Sportfishing regulations before you cast.

FACILITIES	Campground – 29 campsites, drinking water, flush restrooms, hot showers, horseshoe pits, nature trail, emergency phone, mini amphitheater. Check-in: 1:00 pm Check-out: 11:00 am
ACCESS for PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES	The entire campground is accessible. This includes all campsites, spigots, paths, and parking. There are also fully accessible flush restroom and hot shower facilities.
FEES	\$20 / night; \$5 / additional vehicle / night. Sites 2-19 are first-come, first-served and sites 19-31 are available for reservation May 20 thru September 19. Visit www.recreation.gov or call: (877) 444-6777 for further information. Reservation fee applies.
PETS	Pets in campgrounds must be physically restrained by owner on a six-foot or shorter leash.
FIREWOOD	\$6 / bundle; located by host sites.
SEASON	Opens: April 22 Closes: October 24
LOCATION	Travel 29.5 miles east of Roseburg on Highway 138. Elevation: 930'.
HOST	Host on-site to assist with firewood and general questions.
