- /b/ Oregon and California (O&C) and Coos Bay Wagon Road (CBWR) lands. There were no grazing receipts in Fiscal Year 2000 on CBWR lands.
- /c/ Includes mining claim collections (\$487,350) and mining claim holding fee collections (\$8,531,300). Because of a change in collection procedures, mining claim holding fees are initially recorded into a suspense account until adjudicated.
- /d/ Includes receipts from fines, penalties, service charges, and recovery fees (\$15,042,984); interest received from delinquent debt (\$3,194); and interest redeemed from investments under Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act (\$128,996).
- /e/ Land Utilization Project, or LU, lands are purchased by the Federal government under Title III of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act and subsequently transferred to the Department of the Interior. Bankhead-Jones Act receipts from livestock grazing and other resources totaled \$2,015,404.
