

DAY OF LAUNCH

No-Show Penalty

If a Party Leader fails to check-in and utilize their permit on the date of the launch, that person will be penalized as a “No-Show”.

Permit Cancellation Deadline (all spaces): Day before launch by 3pm

Penalty:

Failure to cancel an entire PERMIT (all spaces) by cancellation deadline.

Action: Party Leader will be recorded on the “No-Show” Penalty List.

Listed Party Leader [on the unused Permit] will be unable to control a permit, i.e., be listed as Party Leader or Alternate Party Leader, for the remainder of the current year and all of the next year, including the lottery.

No Penalty:

Cancelling individual spaces on a Permit.

- List Party Leader, Launch Date, and Party Size. An email will be returned confirming your cancellation and release of your spaces.

Picking-Up Your Noncommercial Permit

- Permits will be issued only on the Launch Date at the Smullin Visitor Center at Rand.
- Permit check-in is 7am – 2pm on the Launch Date.
If you fail to check-in by 2pm your permit is void, will be recorded as a No-Show, and the spaces will be given away.
If you know you will be later than 2pm, call and notify us. Your permit may be held until 3pm, when the office will be closed.
- Only the Party Leader or valid Alternate Party Leader may pick up the permit. If the Party Leader cannot pick up the permit and there is no valid Alternate Party Leader, the permit will be canceled. The permit is NOT transferrable to anyone else.
- The Party Leader must be at least 18 years old by the launch date.

Items Are Required at Check-in

The permit will NOT be issued if you fail to present any one of these items:

- Picture ID of Party Leader
- Names and addresses of Party members
- Craft information: type, number of, and colors of craft
*If renting craft, ask the supplier the colors of craft being rented.
- Toilet System must be easily accessible for inspection at check-in.

Separating/Splitting a Permitted Party

- Permitted parties may separate into two groups for launching and during day travel.
- Subgroups must have:
 - Official copy of the permit and an approved toilet system.
 - All party members of the permitted group must be below Grave Creek Falls by midnight on the Launch Date, and camp or lodge together on the entire trip.
 - All listed party members must be present on and complete the entire trip.
