- Robert Jolley reported that the BLM will continue using the existing agreement as before with the regular cooperative agreement payment process. Meeting in Denver – Continue Cooperative Agreement through April 2018

  - o **Note**: All other options were explored in changing this agreement to a contract before final decision was made at Washington level
- Current Funding Agreement ended December 31, 2015 but,
  - o 6 month extension to June 30, 2016
- Now plan is to extended to April 2018. (Completion of 15 year capitalization commitment). Nick is asking for confirmation based on payments made. The BLM will follow the 15 year terms in the agreement.
- CHEU will continue until (2021)
  - o Plan some form of Lease \$/Month for 2-3 years of life to 2021
- Valve integration discussed
- Proposal for Flare line October during planned shutdown.
- October 15, 2016 is Annual planned Shutdown
