Nick D.-Welding repair, BLM to put out solicitation to finish welding work.

Alex C.-Everything is related to the welding job. There is the pipe supports, back fill, nothing unrelated to welding and pipe. Insulation we are handling a different route.

Nick D.-Nothing new on electrical. K200 still has some issues but no show stoppers besides the welding work and the machine leveling.

Heath M.-We have a plan to go after to do the leveling. We just need to work through it we should know something by today. It will have to go through a contract.

Nick D.-Operator training scheduled for Aug 26th, beginning to get close to K200 so I don't know if that will conflict or if they will just mesh.

CO2 analyzer.

Brad B.-Started today or tomorrow and finished by the end of the week.

Nick D.-Air handling and ventilation changes were made to electrical control devices. Mark I got your note about Waukesha #1 shutting down on overheat trip. We need to understand what failed. Are we confident the set points are correct?

Mark M.-It has a radiator setup but the muffler is blocking 1/3 of the discharge. There was no alarm before shutdown. I think we should agree to not use Waukesha #1 during the hot months. We could also pressure wash the radiator which might help.

Brad B.-Don't forget the life safety systems will have louvers.

Nick D.-205 without looking too deeply, 205 for a coolant seemed a little low but I don't know the requirements of the machine. PHA and ambient odor I'm not going to go into depth, I know Ken Morin and Heath are working on those.

Tony K.-Cylinders are in hand at Enerflex I suggest they hold them there until we need them, just a few hours away.
