Mark M.-We started injecting on the 27th and after a few days we increased our injection rate and then backed off of that. Draw was a little more than we anticipated. Pressure is 1272 currently. We are doing 2.9 crude and 1.9 pure. A6 is still out of production. Keeping good records on fluid we are adding to the north methane pump. I will send those records to you Brad. We finally got a rod drop indicator on K610 cylinders 2 and 3. Has to do with the wear indication. We have had this situation before. So, it is good we are going to get into that K610 rebuild next week. Already seeing some activity out here. The scaffolding contractor has been on site and they have the scaffolding built around K600 after cooler.

Nick D.-The goal is to trend the pipeline up until the outage. Siemens contract we did issue a purchase order. There was some work being done on the vent fans. Was that completed?

Mark M.-Yes, yesterday we got that done.
