Sam B. – Update for COVID-19, the BLM has rolled out it is return to office policy. Here at Amarillo we are already at phase I, we have more than 25% of folks in the office due to our critical infrastructure. Be that as it may we are trying to open the office slowly as we get back to normal operations. So officially we are still in phase I as we are moving forward. Amarillo is still considered a hot spot. We know that others may have opened more liberally than here in Amarillo, but I wanted those who may be traveling to know that we do still have cases popping up. Other than that, there are no other big changes. The plant is running well we are holding the pressure between 1300 and 1350. About 87% of our product is being reinjected into the field. We are maintaining the pressure for folks who are trying to take gas on the pipeline. The upcoming plant shutdown is supposed to be on the website for July, it looks like we have been discussing even pushing that into August. So, there is a possibility that will be pushed to August we have to look at availability of personnel and of contractors. There is talk of potentially making it into more than one shut down. All these things are trying to deal with the COVID virus.

We are testing the TEAMS environment, that is what we are doing right now. Bear with us as we gain experience using this new platform. We will be able to share presentations using this platform, so right now we are thinking that this might be our option for the BLM gas storage meeting that we have in July. Let Carole know how you were able to hear things. The next meeting, we will share presentations to see how well that works. I do like this TEAMS versus the live platform so we can answer questions and things like that.
