

A venture into the Oregon Badlands Wilderness is an experience of ancient junipers, volcanic vistas, and sand underfoot. You can explore cracked volcanic pressure ridges, called tumuli, or walk narrow moat-like cracks in the ground. Traces of human history are visible to the careful observer.

At 29,000 acres, the Oregon Badlands Wilder-

ness represents an outstanding example of ancient western juniper woodlands atop Columbia River Basalts. Almost **50 miles** of trails offer the visitor many opportunities for hiking or horseback riding loops of various lengths. As a designated wilderness, the Oregon Badlands Wilderness en-

joys the highest level of permanent protection, giving visitors the opportunity to experience nature at its wildest, while leaving any mechanized uses behind.
