The primary human uses in the unit and the surrounding area are associated with livestock grazing and recreation by the public. The unit is relatively flat and 3,793 acres has been drill seeded with non-native crested wheatgrass with multiple entries over several years following wildfire. The unit currently has the following developments (See Unit Character Map):					

- 1 mile of snow fence
- 17 miles of fencing
- 4 gates

The ID-team found that this unit is not natural due to the number and distribution pattern of the developments combined with the vegetative treatments that have made the imprints of humans substantially noticeable.
