

Modifying Fire Prevention Order CAC06000-20-02

Bakersfield Field Office

Pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.1 and 9212.2, the prohibition(s) listed in Fire Prevention Order No. CAC06000-20-02, regarding Fire Restrictions applicable to the Bakersfield Field Office, issued on Apr. 30, 2020, is hereby rescinded on Dec. 7, 2020 for approximately 640,000 acres of BLM-managed public lands in Fresno, Kern, Kings, Madera, San Luis Obispo and Tulare counties and includes BLM-managed recreational areas, including the Carrizo Plain National Monument, Chimney Peak, Kennedy Meadows, Keysville, Lake Isabella, San Joaquin River Gorge and Three Rivers.

An additional roughly 10,000 acres in Santa Barbara and Ventura counties, which neighbor Los Padres National Forest, will remain in <u>fire restrictions (Order number CA06000-20-02)</u> through Dec. 31.

Pursuant to 43 CFR 8364, TARGET SHOOTING RESTRICTIONS were terminated for the Bakersfield Field Office on Oct. 30. See Central California District <u>news release</u> - <u>full order</u> (Oct. 30)

All provisions of <u>CA910-2020-001</u> remains in effect through Dec. 31.
