Fire Prevention Order

Central Coast Field Office CND-190-20-06

Pursuant to 43 CFR 9212.1 and 9212.2, the Bureau of Land Management Central Coast Field Office is rescinding the temporary fire restrictions established on May 15, 2020, under Fire Prevention Order CND-190-20-03. The temporary prohibition on recreational target shooting was already rescinded on November 13, 2020 under CND-190-20-05. This order applies within the boundaries of the BLM Central Coast Field Office and goes into effect on December 18, 2020.

Prohibitions under 43 CFR §9212.1 and year-round California Fire Order CA910-2020-001 remain in effect. This includes a year-round prohibition on fireworks or pyrotechnic devices, tracer, explosive, steel core or incendiary ammunition, explosive chemical devices or binary exploding targets.
