## Time Outside Together (TOTs): Snow Painting

Resources to explore the natural world with children under five.



### Paint on the Snow!

1. Fill a spray bottle or squirt bottle, such as an old ketchup bottle, with water.
2. Add several drops of food coloring to the water. The more you add, the more vibrant your painting will be.
3. Go outside and find a place with clean snow. Choose a spot away from sensitive areas, such as waterways.
4. Use the bottle to start painting on the snow. Use additional bottles and food coloring to create more colors for your painting.
5. Optional: Create a snow sculpture and use the spray bottle(s) to paint it.
