• Photographs must be taken between January 1, 2019 and Aug. 31, 2021.

PHOTO GUIDELINES

- BLM Nevada and Travel Nevada assumes all rights to your photo once submission has been sent.
- Only submit photos that you have personally taken—LIMIT SUBMISSIONS>> your top 10
- Anyone in the photo <u>must</u> know they are in the photo and <u>must</u> have given written consent to appear in the image.
- Photo requirements
 - Must be formatted to IPEG
 - Please ensure that the photo is 300dpi or at least 5 MB or larger with a high resolution. [Winning photos must work in print.]
 - o MUST have photo descriptions formatted as follows:
 - Image: Desert Tortoise
 - Location: Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area
 - BLM District [if known]: Southern Nevada District
 - Photographer: John Doe

HOW THE PHOTOS ARE JUDGED

Photos will be judged on the following criteria:

- Originality
- Artistic Composition
- Technical Quality
- Photographic Technique
- Whether the photograph showcases the best of BLM's recreational opportunities
- Adhering to photo guidelines and descriptions [mentioned above.]
