

RRCNCA Guest Climbing Lottery DUE by September 1, 2021:

SRP application (2930-1 form)	Indicate for one year consideration and
completely filled out and signed	specific dates if you know these.

All applications will be evaluated to ensure they meet the mandate of the National Conservation Area establishment and that they follow the Resource Management Plan Guidelines (RMP) established for the Conservation Area.

The RMP does limit the number of certain types of Full-time recreation permits (Daily or monthly) allowed for the Conservation Area. These include four guided Off-Road Vehicle tours, four guided bike tour companies, five guided hiking tour companies, three guided horseback tour companies, and five guided climbing companies.

The RMP also established limited "guest" guided climbing companies for periods not to exceed 10 days annually or two-five day periods. Currently this is limited to 8 commercial companies and four educational organized groups. Applications for these permits are only taken at a specified period and are on a one-year lottery system.

Certain videography and photography may require additional permitting. You should contact Joanie Guerrero, jjguerrero@blm.gov for information about this process and if your photography meets the definition of requiring a permit.

SCHEDULE A PRE-APPLICATION MEETING- After selection	Contact the BLM Recreation Staff through <u>rrc_reservations@blm.gov</u> to set up a virtual/in-person meeting. Please be prepared to have the following information below ready for this meeting.
Operating Business plan/Map	Sufficient detail to determine if health and safety considerations, Natural resource concerns are addressed. BLM approved maps may be used for general routes. More detail maps, including schematic maps of staging and aid stations may be required. We will also need to know if vending and other forms of financial support are being obtained by the promoter. A list of approved routes will be provided by BLM (starting 2021)
Signed additional stipulations	These will be sent after operations plans are reviewed. These include LNT and Wilderness Education by permittee for clients using Wilderness. MAXIMUM OF TEN DAYS PER CALENDAR YEAR OR TWO-FIVE DAY PERIODS
Copy of (NV)state business license	"current" Out of state will need to also get NV State business licenses.
Copy of workman's comp insurance And list of employees/staff/volunteers.	This must be updated as guides/staff are separated or added.

Recreation.gov account	Be aware that the Red Rock Scenic Drive is on a reservation system for vehicle entry from Oct- May. We will need you to send us the information to put your company/organization into the approve groups to receive access to discounted timed tickets into the Scenic Drive.
