Notice of Emergency Closure of Public Lands in Trinity County

AGENCY: Bureau of Land Management, Redding Field Office

ACTION: Notice of Emergency Closure of Public Lands

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) associated with emergency fire suppression actions for the Monument Fire in Trinity County are closed to public access to reduce risk to public and firefighter safety. Exempted from this closure are personnel and vehicles involved with fire suppression, and state, local and federal officials involved with enforcement.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This closure is in effect with the posting of this notice and remains in effect until the authorized officer determines that the fire no longer poses a risk to public safety and the facility is no longer needed to support fire suppression efforts. This closure is effective pursuant to 43 CFR Subpart 83464.1 (a).
