QUOTA FOR HIGH SEASON OVERNIGHT BOATER PERMITS

Online permits are required to boat year-round between Service Creek and Tumwater Falls and can only be obtained on Recreation.gov. The following table shows the number of High Season Overnight boater permits that will be released daily on Recreation.gov. Permits will become available 4 months and 1 month in advance of a given High Season launch date (see the High Season Release Schedule).

**Long Distance Paddle Permits can put in at any legal access point upstream of Clarno in Segment 3 (Upstream of Service Creek, Service Creek, Twickenham, Priest Hole, Burnt Ranch) and takeout at any legal access point downstream of Clarno (Thirtymile, J.S. Burres-Cottonwood, Starvation Lane, Rock Creek, McDonald Crossing). Long distance permits are for parties doing long trips and do not allow for parties to takeout at Clarno.
