Fire Prevention Order

Ukiah Field Office Order Number CAC05000-19-01

In compliance with **Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 9212.2**, the following acts are prohibited on Public Lands within the Bureau of Land Management's Ukiah Field Office jurisdiction beginning at 12:01 a.m. on July 01, 2019 and continuing until further notice:

- 1. No motorized vehicles or tools powered by internal combustion engines off established roads or trails (such as chainsaws or lawn mowers).
- 2. No target shooting hot bullet fragments, exploding targets and metal from recreational shooting can spark a wildfire. Use of firearms for hunting is still allowed. Hunters must abide by State of California laws and regulations.
- 3. No smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, or at a developed recreation site, or other designated areas.
- 4. No fireworks, including "safe and sane" fireworks.
- 5. No welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame.
- 6. No explosives.
- 7. No campfires, barbecues or open fires, except in a developed campground. Portable stoves using gas, jelled petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel are exempt from this restriction with a valid "California Campfire Permit".

Only the following shall be exempt from the restrictions and closure of this order:

- a) Persons with a valid permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited acts.
- b) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Penalties

- a) In accordance with the penalty provisions in 43 CFR 9212.4 any violation of this order is a class A misdemeanor. Any person who knowingly and willfully violates this Fire Prevention Order, upon conviction shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100,000 and/or imprisonment for not more than 12 months.
- b) Civil and administrative penalties may also be assessed for damages to public lands, government property and facilities, along with suppression costs associated with fire suppression efforts.
- c) Any instrumentality or evidence of an offense involved in, or used, or intended to be used in any violation of this order shall be subject to seizure, forfeiture and disposal.
