## 12 Million Acres

is managed by BLM in Idaho...that is about the size of 9 million football fields or the states of Vermont and New Hampshire.

## 1,100 Miles of River

recreation is managed by BLM.

## 5.7 Million Visits

occur each year to BLM recreation sites including St. Anthony Sand Dunes, Hulls Gulch, Lake Coeur d'Alene, and rivers including the Salmon, Clearwater, Big Lost and Snake.

## 708 Youth Volunteers

contributed valuable hours to improve wildlife habitat for over 200 species.

## Work Outside

11,000 jobs are supported by public lands in Idaho.

## Float and Fish

the Salmon aka "*The River of No Return*" with 425 miles of free-flowing water. Paddle the Owyhee or Bruneau Wild and Scenic Rivers. Drift along the Henry's Fork to catch a trout.

## Explore and Camp

out your back door surrounded by Idaho's best mountains, canyons, volcanos, fish and wildlife.

## Hike

Idaho has the most wilderness in the U.S. outside Alaska. Eight wilderness areas, a national conservation area, and a national monument are managed by BLM.

## Climb

to the top of 8 of Idaho's highest peaks in the Lost River Range including Mount Borah.
