

Camping north and south of I-70 is allowed only at campgrounds or camping areas identified with one of these symbols or camping sites with a developed metal fire ring - identified with this symbol. Camping limit is 7 days.

CAMPING ON THE COLORADO RIVER
Note: A permit is required to camp along the Ruby-Horsethief section of the Colorado River. Permits can be obtained through Recreation.gov
