


TYEE RECREATION SITE

WELCOME TO TYEE RECREATION SITE!

Take a deep breath and get ready to relax on the shores of one of the best rivers in Oregon. Tye Recreation Site has 15 non-reservable campsites and is located on the main stem of the Umpqua River. Many of the campsites are located right on the bank of the river. A day-use picnic area and 50 person pavilion offer an exceptional setting for small group activities. Easy access to the river allows for fishing and water play opportunities. Keep an eye towards the sky for a chance to see the resident Osprey in the day-use area.



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- ✓ **CAMPGROUND** is open year round, but sites 11–15 are open from late-April to Mid-October. All campsites (except site #1), restrooms, water spigots, and the pavilion are wheelchair accessible.
- ✓ **RESERVE** the pavilion at [recreation.gov](https://www.recreation.gov) or call 1-877-444-6777.
- ✓ **PETS** are allowed in the campground but must be on a 6-foot or shorter leash.

DIRECTIONS

From I-5 in Sutherlin, Oregon, head west 12 miles on Highway 138. At Bullock Bridge, just past Tye Landing, turn left/south and then an immediate right onto County Road 57; the campground is 1/2 mile downstream.




