Fire Prevention Order

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is required to take all necessary actions to protect human life, public lands, and resources and improvements thereon through the prevention of wildfires. The BLM complies with Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 9212.2 that requires the BLM to establish fire prevention orders to assist with wildland fire prevention efforts throughout the geographical area.

Under the authority of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1701 et. Seq.) and pursuant to 43 CFR §9212.2, the following acts are prohibited on all BLM-administered lands within the Roseburg District to prevent human-caused fire and reduce wildfire potential.

This prohibition will become effective at 12:01 a.m. (local time) on the 15th day of June 2020 and will remain in effect until further notice.

PROHIBITION:

1. Setting, building, maintaining, or using open fire, including charcoal briquettes, except at designated campgrounds.

(Portable cooking stoves with shut-off valves using liquefied or bottled fuels are allowed).

2. Smoking while traveling in timber, brush, or grass areas, except in vehicles on roads or while stopped in an area at least three (3) feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material.

3. Operating any type of motorized vehicle except on roadways clear of flammable vegetation. Parking of vehicles off roadways must be done in an area barren of flammable material.

4. Operating any type of motorized vehicle on the Roseburg District, BLM, without the following:
 - a. One shovel not less than twenty-six (26) inches in overall length with a blade not less than eight (8) inches wide.
 - b. One water container of at least one (1) gallon filled to capacity, or a 2.5 pound fire extinguisher, ABC, fully charged.
 - c. One axe, with a handle twenty-six (26) inches in length and a head weight of not less than two (2) pounds.

5. Using chainsaws or any other equipment with internal combustion engines for felling, bucking, skidding, wood cutting or any other operation is prohibited.

6. Welding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame.

Pursuant to Title 43 CFR 9213.3 (a), the following **are exempt** from this order:

1. Persons with a permit or contract issued by the BLM Roseburg District, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any federal, state, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force while in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions under Title 43 CFR is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment of not more than twelve months, or both. Violations may also be subject to the enhanced fines provided for by Title 18 U.S.C. 3571 (\$100,000 and up to twelve months)
