- (1) A **RED** number in above table indicates the State or Washington Office had two or more of its organizational units in that fiscal year NOT rated in good safety, health, and environmental condition.
- (2) A **GREEN** number in above table indicates the State or Washington Office had all or all, but one of its organizational units in that fiscal year rated in good safety, health, and environmental condition.
- (3) The performance goal for FY 2016 was to have 96% of the BLM's organizational units rated in good safety, health, and environmental condition which is one percent higher than last fiscal year's performance.
- (4) The above data includes responses from the field through July 2016.
- (5) FY 2016 is the twelfth fiscal year in which an organizational unit must have all its high priority traditional CASHE findings completed to be rated in good condition.
- (6) FY 2016 is the third fiscal year in which an organizational unit must have all its high priority RI CASHE findings completed to be rated in good condition.
- (7) In FY 2017 and subsequent years an organizational unit must have zero incomplete high priority traditional CASHE and RI CASHE findings and no more than five incomplete high priority SI CASHE findings to be rated in good condition.
- (8) The number of incomplete high priority SI CASHE findings an organization unit will be allowed to have and be rated in good condition will drop to:
 - a. four or less in FY 2018;
 - b. three or less in FY 2019;
 - c. two or less in FY 2020;
 - d. one or less in FY 2021; and
 - e. zero in FY 2022
