Fire Prevention Order

Northern California District, Arcata Field Office

CA-330-19-02

In compliance with **Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 9212.2**, the following acts are **prohibited** on Public Lands, roads within the Bureau of Land Management, Arcata Field Office jurisdiction beginning July 1st, 2019, and continuing until further notice:

- 1.a Build, maintain, attend, or use any open fire, campfire, charcoal barbecue or stove outside of metal fire rings or stoves provided within a designated developed recreation site (see exhibit A), or a specifically posted campsite or area. Portable stoves using gas, jelled petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel are exempt from this restriction with a valid "California Campfire Permit". Portable stoves are allowed along the Lost Coast Trail, King Range National Conservation Area.
- 2.a Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, at a designated developed recreation site or other designated areas.
- 3.a To operate or cause to be operated any OHV, portable tool or device powered by an internal combustion engine off of established roads or trails on Public Lands. An exemption is in place for the Samoa Dunes Recreation Area and along the waveslope of the Mike Thompson Wildlife Area, South Spit Humboldt Bay.
- 4.a Possess or discharge a firearm using incendiary, tracer, steel core, or armor piercing ammunition.
5. To possess or use exploding targets.
- 6.a To possess or discharge fireworks, including "safe and sane" fireworks. An exemption is in place for July 4th when State Fire Marshall-approved fireworks can be used within designated areas at Samoa Dunes Recreation Area. The exemption from the restrictions is for July 4, 2019, only.

Pursuant to **43 CFR 9212.2 (3)**, the following persons are exempt from this order: Anyone with a special-use permit, specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or any Federal, State, or local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 12 months, or both. (**Title 43, C.F.R. 9212.4**)

The area, roads, and trails affected by this order are all BLM Public Lands within the boundaries of the Arcata Field Office, Bureau of Land Management, for the counties of Humboldt, Del Norte, Mendocino, and Trinity.
