	Federal defendants, U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM), et al., submit this Notice	
22	of Filing of Quarterly Report No. 2 to inform the court and the parties as to BLM's progress in	
23	implementing the requirements in paragraphs (1)-(6) of the court's January 29, 2011, Order Re:	
24	Remedy (Doc. 243 at 14-15), Center for Biological Diversity v. U.S. Bureau of Land	
25	Management, 2011 Westlaw 337364, *10 (N.D. Cal. Jan. 29, 2011).	
26	1. On March 30, 2011, BLM filed a notice regarding the Sign Implementation	
27	Strategy (Doc. 249).	
28	2. On July 1, 2011, BLM filed Quarterly Re	eport No. 1 (Doc. 257), noting that (1) all
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signing would be completed by July 27, 2011, (2) map revisions were underway, (3) the agency had adopted a monitoring plan to determine compliance with route closures and whether new routes are being created, (4) it was continuing to gather information about air quality, the Mojave fringe-toed lizard, and riparian areas, (5) it had completed a plan to maintain the open route network and installed informational kiosks at all major OHV access points, and (6) it had completed and posted a plan for law enforcement.

- 3. On August 30, 2011, BLM filed a notice (Doc. 277) regarding the completion of the map updates and revisions, as well as BLM enforcement efforts.
- 4. On September 13, 2011, BLM published in the Federal Register a "Notice of Intent to Prepare an Environmental Document and Proposed Plan Amendment for the West Mojave (WEMO) Plan, Motorized Vehicle Access Element, Inyo, Kern and Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties, CA." A copy of the Federal Register Notice is attached as Exhibit A. The Notice commenced the National Environmental Policy Act scoping process to comply with the Order Re: Remedy.

BLM will post this quarterly report on the agency's website to provide transparency and public access to the planning process and file the next quarterly report by December 31, 2011.
