From 1979: ...located in the Umpqua River about 20 miles northwest of Roseburg. The island has a terraced surface typical of river islands and ranges from 5 to 40 feet above water level during the summer. The dominant vegetation is California-laurel, Polystichum minitum, and Rhus diversiloba."

2012: Myrtle Island is heavily forested at the northern end, the southern end sustains the brunt of the flooding impacts each year and the vegetation is much shorter and thinner. There is a substantial Scotch Broom population at the southern end of the Island. In the heavily vegetated northern end, numerous large myrtlewood trees are interspersed with coniferous evergreens. There were about 10 Canada Geese nested at the northern end. At least 5 thinned or cut areas are visible from the view-shed surrounding the island.
