

# How to Connect to FS Wifi Network

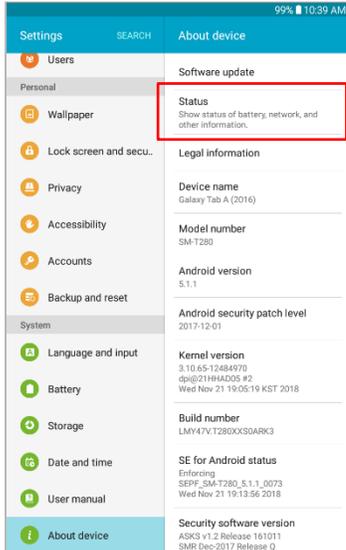
## Why Connect to FS Network Instead of FS Guest

As you might have noticed, when using FS Auth-Guest, the network may time out and force you to reconnect and re-authenticate frequently. This can be extremely frustrating, and time consuming. To alleviate this frustration, you can request to have your WiFi Only device mapped to the FS Network. You should know that this process does NOT require the installation of Mobile Iron to the device, and this is only available for government purchased devices.

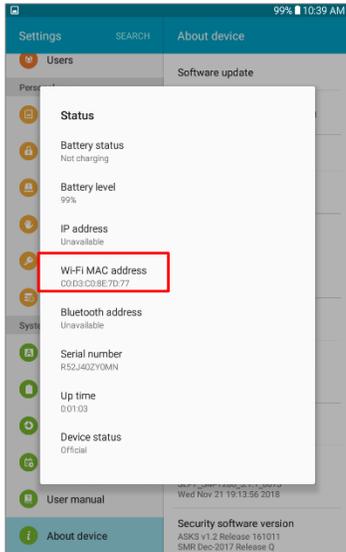
## Process to register device for FS Network access

On your Wifi Only Mobile Device:

- Go to Settings -> General -> About Device and tap Status



- Record the Wi-Fi Mac address

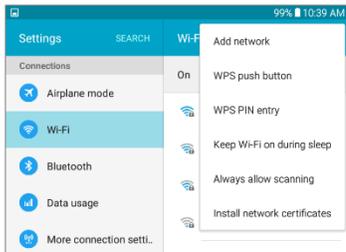


- Go to the CIO Mobile Wifi Access Sharepoint Site, [HERE](#)
- Under *Requestor: Your Access Requests*:, submit all requested information

\*An email is not automatically generated to notify the listed supervisor of the request. Please copy the SharePoint site information into an email to the listed supervisor. They will need to fill out the information under *Supervisors: Requests for You to Review*

Once the device has been approved:

- Go to **Settings** -> **Wi-Fi**, tap **MORE**
- Select **Add Network**



- Set Network name to **3FTW101**
- Security is **802.1x EAP**
  - EAP Method – **PEAP**
  - Phase 2 Authentication – **MSCHAPV2**
  - CA Certificate – leave as (unspecified)
  - Identify – **AD username**
  - Anonymous identity – leave blank
  - Password – **AD password**
