The North island is approximately 3 feet above sea level. Both islands offer limited access portals at higher tides.

<u>Vegetation Features:</u> The South island supports a variety of grasses, wildlfowers, lichens, mosses and several trees. The North island is covered in dust lichens.

Major human uses/ activities: Recreational boating both motorized and non-motorized does occur in the area. Wildlife viewing is excellent in this area for seabirds, marine mammals and other species. Photography is excellent in this area. Sea Kayaking is also excellent in this area. Blind Islands, north and south are located within Eastsound, of Orcas Island and approximately 50'- 100' feet from shore

Other items: Access is best using small non motorized human powered water craft. There is a WADFW Marine mammal haul out site nearby, #448.

Blind Islands, north and south receive a large number of sea kayak visitors who kayak in the area most often kayaking from nearby Rosario resort and also nearby residents. The North island's recreational opportunities are not outstanding due to the proximity of nearby development which would detract from the overall recreational experience as outstanding. 


