<u>Vegetation Features:</u> Unnamed Rocks supports a variety of lichens and seaweeds.

<u>Major human uses/ activities:</u> Recreational boating both motorized and nonmotorized does occur in the area. Wildlife viewing is excellent in this area for seabirds, marine mammals and other species. Sea Kayaking is also excellent in this area. Unnamed Rocks are located just offshore, approximately 20- 280', from Lummi Island on the western shore located north northwest of 13-3, Lummi Rocks within 1 mile. The smaller groupings of rocks are connected to Lummi Island during low tide events.

<u>Other items:</u> Access is best using small non motorized human powered water craft due to numerous submerged rocks in the area and shoreline of Lummi Island. Best access is during low tide. 

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
