NOTICE OF ADDENDUM NO. 3

This amends the Colorado State Office, Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale Notice, dated February 10, 2012, for the Lease Sale Auction to be held on May 10, 2012.

All lands are subject to Exhibit LS-101 Timing Limitation to protect wintering elk, mule deer, pronghorn antelope and/or bighorn sheep.

All lands are subject to Exhibit CO-28 to protect all types of riparian areas.

All lands are subject to Exhibit CO-34 to alert lessee of potential habitat for a threatened, endangered, candidate, or other special status plant or animal.

All lands are subject to Exhibit CO-39 to protect cultural resources.

All lands are subject to Exhibit LS-105 No Surface Occupancy to protect perennial water sources.

The following lands are subject to Exhibit LS-108 Medium Priority Habitat Controlled Surface Use. A 5 percent surface disturbance limitation and a POD illustrating a strategy to leave large blocks of undisturbed habitat will be required for development of this lease:
