

4) USFS Alternatives and Draft Decision

USFS FEIS Alternatives

- <u>A- No Action</u>: Continue leasing program, potentially making new leases available under 1993 decision (areas available and stipulations)
- B- No Future Leasing: Issue no new leases on the WRNF
- <u>C- Proposed Action</u>: Issue new leases in areas identified as available for leasing with new stipulations [*Note: all areas of existing leases would be available for future leasing under this alternative*]

USFS Proposed Decision

Combines Alternative B and Alternative C to close some areas to future leasing, while making others available with the stipulations identified in Alternative C. Closes ~30% of "high potential" areas in the WRNF to future leasing.



4) BLM Conceptual Alternatives

- 1. <u>No Action</u>: Take no action and continue to administer leases per current terms and conditions (i.e. reaffirm the leases)
- 2. <u>Minor/Regulatory Modifications</u>: Modify only leases that are (a) missing stipulations identified in 1993, or (b) where stipulations are warranted to ensure compliance with regulations (e.g. CAA, CWA, ESA).
- 3. <u>USFS Proposed Action Stipulations</u>: Match 2014 USFS Proposed Action stipulations (Alternative C).
- 4. <u>USFS (Proposed) Future Leasing Decision</u>: Match 2014 USFS Proposed Decision. Match stipulations in area open to future leasing. Void leases in areas closed to future leasing.
- 5. <u>Void the leases</u>: Void all leases.
