
What is White Nose Syndrome

A Fungal Disease Causing Infections on Hibernating Bats.


- Signs:
- White Fungus evident on Nose, Ears or Wings
- Depleted Body Fat
- Abnormal Behavior
 - Flying outside during daylight in winter.
 - Clustering during the winter near cave entrance

Causes of Spread



Bat to Bat

Clustering behavior promotes transmission.

Potential Cave to Human to Bat

Geographical spread.

Proposed Targeted Closures

Seasonal/Year round Closures – Caves and Abandoned Mines Important for Bats

Two Criterion being considered for defining important caves/targeted closures

Three alternatives being proposed for analysis
