What to Know Before You Go Instructions for visitors for the Pine Nut Mountains Wild Horse Gather

Where to meet/lodging: Those who want to view gather operations are asked to call the Pine Nut Gather Hotline at (775) 885-6101 at least one day in advance to receive specific instructions on meeting locations and times. The hotline will be updated each day by 7:00 p.m.

<u>Transportation</u>: All visitors must have their own transportation. Vehicles must be 4-wheel drive with a high clearance. Make sure the gas tank is topped off before traveling to the gather. Visitors must have spare tires.

<u>Amenities</u>: Participants must provide their own transportation, water and food. Public restrooms will not be available onsite. **Most, if not all observation locations will require participants to hike up to 1 ½ mile within a certain timeframe.**

<u>Weather conditions</u>: Weather conditions in Nevada can change rapidly, therefore be prepared for possible wind and rain. Plan on highs in the 90's and lows in the high 50s.

What to bring:

- Closed-toed sturdy shoes
- Hats
- Sunscreen
- Food and water
- Binoculars

Clothing should be natural coloring. Avoid white and bright colors while at the gather.

*There are NO bathrooms at the trap site so plan accordingly.
