If the purchaser makes any material misrepresentations in the applicable "Application to Purchase Wild Horses and Burros," "Bill of Sale," or during any negotiations with the BLM leading up to purchase, including, without limitations, representations about the purposes and/or use for which the animals are obtained, then the sale is voidable at the discretion of the BLM.

Purchased wild horses and/or burros cannot be returned to the public lands unless the BLM has issued a permit or otherwise authorized the purchaser to do so, such as through a livestock grazing or recreational permit.

Purchaser understands the listed animals are wild and ungentle, and due to their age and temperament may never become accustomed to human contact or be trainable for handling like domestic livestock.

Purchaser agrees to provide adequate facilities to contain and care for these animals.

Purchaser acknowledges that the seller makes no express or implied warranties as to the merchantability or fitness for any particular purpose for any wild horses or burros purchased under this program.

Upon sale, the listed animals are no longer considered wild free-roaming wild horses or burros. Sale of animals is final upon pick-up, which is the responsibility of the purchaser.
