
Thirtymile / Armstrong Road Seasonal Closure



There is a seasonal closure in place that closes Armstrong Canyon Road to motorized vehicles from December 1 – April 15 each year. Visitors can still access the area on foot, by bike or horseback, or by boat year round. Bicycles are allowed on all roads year-round, except those designated as non-mechanized (trails in the Wilderness Study Area).

Public lands are open for legal hunting unless specifically closed. For specific hunting regulations, information about tags, or registration, contact the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Dispersed camping is allowed and campfires are allowed in a firepan only within the river corridor October 1—May 31. There are no campfire restrictions outside of the river corridor; during this time. Please follow basic campfire safety rules including making sure your campfire is "dead out" when no one is present to watch it.



Access to Armstrong Canyon Road and the Thirtymile boat launch is restricted at the entrance to the BLM-administered lands (see red line on left side of map). The sole public access to the Thirtymile area is off of Buckhorn Lane to Armstrong Road. Please respect private property and stay on the roadway along the fenced easement portions.

The closure is in place from December 1—April 15 each year.
