## Improve a Habitat!

### Directions

1. Take a walk outside around the place you live. Look for ways animals might find the food, water, and shelter they need.
2. Use natural materials you find outside or recycled materials from your home to make habitat improvements that provide additional food, water, or shelter.
3. Watch to see what animals take advantage of the improvements you make!

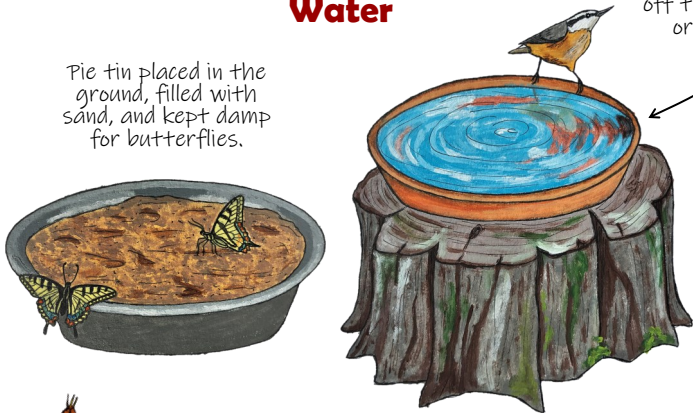
### Habitat Helper Tips

- Be Bear Aware! Avoid putting food-related items outside between mid-April and mid-November.
- Keep yourself and animals safe: Do not touch or get close to wildlife.
- Use materials that are safe for animals.
- Keep feeders and water dishes clean and well stocked.
- Remember to ask for permission if you want to put anything in a public space.
