HOLIDAY TREE PERMITS

For the 2021 holiday season, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will begin offering non-commercial holiday tree permits to cut pinyon pine, juniper, and fir trees in Utah.



PERMITS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE ONLINE AND IN-PERSON DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS AT YOUR LOCAL BLM OFFICE.



HOW TO HELP

- ✓ Early season cutting is advised as winter weather conditions in the mountains are unpredictable.
- ✓ Be prepared for slick, snow-packed roads and carry chains. Use a four-wheel drive vehicle or snow machine in many locations.
- ✓ Stay on designated roads and trails, and respect private property boundaries.
- ✓ If you have a campfire, please extinguish it completely before you leave the site. Do not leave unattended.
- ✓ Please help keep our public lands beautiful! Trash and litter: "Pack It In, Pack It Out."

SAFETY TIPS

- ✓ Keep safety in mind when finding and cutting your tree.
- ✓ Watch weather forecasts and avoid traveling in bad weather.
- ✓ Let someone know where you plan to go and your time of return.
- ✓ Be prepared for winter emergencies: carry a flashlight, cell phone, shovel, first-aid kit, matches, axe or handsaw, additional warm clothing, and a rope to secure your tree.
- ✓ Drive defensively and cautiously!
