

The virtual public information forum will gather public input on the proposed Copper Rays Solar Project in order to better inform will inform BLM's determination on whether to continue to process or to deny the Copper Rays Solar Project right-of-way application. The virtual public information forum will begin with a short presentation on the application evaluation and provide information about the Copper Rays Solar Project, will continue with a question-and-answer session, and finish with a public input period.
