Recreation Fee Program Spending & Accomplishment Highlights 2021

Winnemucca Sand Dunes Project

In partnership with the Nevada State OHV Commission and BLM, the Northern Nevada ATV group constructed the Winnemucca Sand Dunes facilities. The facilities are located on BLM land off US Hwy 95 in Winnemucca, Nevada. Facilities were completed in January of 2022. The Nevada State OHV Commission awarded a grant to Northern Nevada ATV for the recreational developments at the Dunes. The grant covered the cost of required NEPA analysis, and the purchase and installation of new facilities such as, a dual vault toilet, trash receptacles, picnic tables, shade shelters, and kiosks. The 1232 funds covered BLM's portion of the agreement, including labor, materials, equipment, and boulder placement for grant matching.

In FY 2021, the Humboldt River Field Office filled the much-needed Park Ranger position. The new ranger identified needed tools and equipment to maintain and improve recreational trails and sites in our field office, including the purchase of trail maintenance hand tools, power tools, safety equipment, etc. With 1232 funds, we were able to provide most of these items.

Recreation Fee Dollars

They support and enhance:

- Maintenance, repair, and facility enhancement related directly to visitor enjoyment, visitor access, and health and safety
- Interpretation, visitor information, visitor service, visitor needs assessments, and signs
- Habitat restoration directly related to wildlife- dependent recreation that is limited to hunting, fishing, wildlife observation, or photography
- Law enforcement related to public use and recreation direct operating, or capital costs associated with the recreation fee program

Recreation fee dollars are an investment in outdoor recreation. Current and future generations benefit as 100% of the funds collected are reinvested in the facilities and services that visitors enjoy, use, and value.
